

In pursuance of the provisions of clause (3) of Article 348 of the Constitution, the Governor is pleased to order the publication of the following English translation of notification no.3038 /Chh-pu-10-2013-27(65)/2012, dated 11 December, 2013

In exercise of the powers under sub-section (2) of section 46 read with sub-section (3) of the said section, section-2 of the Police Act, 1861 (Act no. 5 of 1861) and all other powers enabling him in this

behalf, the Governor is pleased to make the following rules with a view to amending the Uttar Pradesh Sub-Inspector and Inspector (Civil Police) Service Rules, 2008 :-

THE UTTAR PRADESH SUB-INSPECTOR AND INSPECTOR (CIVIL POLICE) SERVICE (SEVENTH AMENDMENT) RULES, 2013

1. (1) These rules may be called the Uttar Pradesh Sub-Inspector and Inspector (Civil Police) Service (Seventh Amendment) Rules, 2013.

Short title and commencement

(2) They shall come into force with effect from the date of their publication in the Gazette.

2. In the Uttar Pradesh Sub-Inspector and Inspector (Civil Police) Service Rules, 2008 hereinafter referred to as the said rules, in rule 5 for the existing sub-rule (1) set out in Column 1 below, the sub-rule as set out in Column 2 shall be substituted, namely :-

Amendment of rule 5

COLUMN - 1

Existing sub-rule

(1) Sub-Inspector

(1) Fifty percent by direct recruitment through the Board.

The recruitments of dependents of those employees who died during their service is also made in accordance with the Dying in Harness Rules 1974. The appointing authority shall make the recruitment under this rule.

(2) Fifty percent by promotion through the Board on the basis of departmental examination from amongst substantively appointed Head Constables and Constables of the Uttar Pradesh Civil Police/Armed Police/Mounted Police/P.A.C. who fulfils the following eligibility conditions:-

(a) must have completed three years service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment excluding the probation period;

(b) Must not have attained the age of more than 40 years on the first day of the year of recruitment.

COLUMN - 2

Sub-rule as here by substituted

(1) Sub-Inspector

(i) Fifty percent by direct recruitment through the Board.

(ii) Fifty percent by promotion through the Board on the basis of seniority subject to the rejection of the unfit from amongst substantively appointed Head Constables of Uttar Pradesh Civil Police who have completed three years of service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment.

(iii) Sub-Inspectors (Civil Police) promoted on ex-cadre posts who fulfil the requirement mentioned in clause (ii) shall also be eligible for promotion to the post of Sub-Inspector.

3. In the said rules, for existing rule 10 set out in Column 1 below, the rule as set out in Column 2 shall be substituted, namely :-

COLUMN - 1

Existing Rule

10- A candidate for direct recruitment must have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of more than 28 years on the first day of July of calendar year in which vacancies for direct recruitment are advertised:

such other categories as may be specified.

COLUMN - 2*Rule as here by substituted*

Scheduled caste, Scheduled Tribe and such other categories shall be such as may be specified:

Provided further that the candidates who have applied for recruitment to the post of Sub Inspector Civil Police in pursuance of the notification no. PRPB:One-1/2011 dated 19 May, 2011 issued by the Uttar Pradesh Police Recruitment and Promotion Board but the recruitment to the said post could not be made, shall be given relaxation in maximum age limit so that they may be eligible to appear in the next recruitment to the said post.

Amendment
of rule 16

4. In the said rules, for existing rule 16 set out in Column 1 below, the rule as set out in Column 2 shall be substituted, namely :-

COLUMN - 1*Existing Rule*

16. Procedure for recruitment by promotion to the post of Sub-Inspector- For the purpose of recruitment by promotion on the basis of departmental examination to the post of Sub- Inspector, the Board shall conduct a written examination in the following manner:

(a) Written Examination

(i) The eligible candidates, shall be required to appear in a written examination which shall carry 300 marks. The details of the subjects included in the written examination and the marks allotted for each subject are as follows.-

Subject	Maximum Marks
1. Hindi Essay (based on Law marks and Order case study and police functioning)	100
2. Basic Law, Constitution and Police Procedure (objective type) (Indian Penal Code, Criminal Procedure Code Evidence Act and Police Manual etc.)	100
3. Numerical and Mental / marks Ability Test (objective type)	50

COLUMN - 2*Rule as here by substituted*

16 Promotion on the basis of Seniority- Fifty percent of the total number of sanctioned posts of Sub-Inspector Civil Police shall be filled by recruitment through promotion on the basis of seniority subject to rejection of unfit, alongwith physical efficiency test which is of qualifying nature, through the Board on the basis of the recommendation of the selection committee.

(a) The selection committee shall,-

(i) be constituted by the Chairman of the Board in accordance with the Government orders for the time being in force.

(ii) be headed by an Inspector General of Police nominated by the Chairman of the Board,

(iii) have Deputy Inspector General of Police (Establishment) as ex-officio member of the committee, who will also put up undisputed seniority list and service record of eligible candidates before the Selection Committee in accordance with the Government orders for the time being in force.

(iv) have a nominee of the Director General of Police Uttar Pradesh, not below the rank of Superintendent of Police.
