

In pursuance of the provisions of clause (3) of Article 348 of the Constitution, the Governor is pleased to order the publication of the following English translation of notification no. 1591/vi-pu-01-13-115/2008, dated 10 May, 2013

In exercise of the powers under clause (c) of sub-section (2) of section 46 read with sub-section (3) of the said section and section 2 of the Police Act, 1861 (Act no. 5 of 1861) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor is pleased to make the following rules with a view to amending the Uttar Pradesh Civil Police Constable and Head Constable Service Rules, 2008 :—

THE UTTAR PRADESH POLICE CONSTABLE AND HEAD CONSTABLE SERVICE (FOURTH AMENDMENT) RULES, 2013

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) These rules may be called the Uttar Pradesh Police Constable and Head Constable Service (Fourth Amendment) Rules, 2013.

(2) They shall come into force with effect from the date of their publication in the *Gazette*.

Amendment of rule-10

2. In the Uttar Pradesh Police Constable and Head Constable Service Rules, 2008 herein after referred as the said rules, for rule 10 set out in column I below the rule as set out in column II shall be substituted, namely :-

COLUMN I

Existing rules

10. Age - A candidate for direct recruitment to the post of Constable must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 22 years in case of a male candidate and in case of female candidate she must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 25 years.

Provided that the upper age limit in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled castes, Scheduled Tribes and such other categories as may be greater by such number of years as may be specified in the Act and Government orders applicable at the time of recruitment.

COLUMN II

Rules as hereby substituted

10. Age - A candidate for direct recruitment to the post of Constable must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 22 years in case of a male candidate and in case of female candidate she must have attained the age of 18 years and must not have attained the age of 25 years.

Provided that the upper age limit in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and such other categories as may be greater by such number of years as may be specified in the Act and Government orders applicable at the time of recruitment.

Provided further that the candidates who have applied for recruitment to the post of Police Constable in pursuance of the notification no. PRBP-दो-1 (2)/2011, dated July 15, 2011 issued by the Uttar Pradesh Police Recruitment and Promotion Board but the recruitment to the said post could not be made shall be given relaxation in maximum age limit so that they may be eligible to appear in the next recruitment to the said post.

Amendment of rule-15

3. In the said rules in rule 15 for clause (g) set out in column I below the clause as set out in column II shall be *substituted*, namely:-

COLUMN I

Existing clause

(g) Selection and Merit List-

The Board shall prepare a final select list of candidates in order of their merit, keeping in view the reservation policy of the State.

COLUMN II

Clause as hereby substituted

(g) Selection and Merit List-

(i) A merit list shall be prepared by the Board amongst the candidates found successful after Physical Standard Tests and Medical Examination.

NOTE : If two or more candidates obtain equal marks then the merit list would be finalized, according to the following procedure:-

(i) Such candidate will be given preference having Preferential qualification, if any. A candidate having
