In exercise of the powers under sub-section (2) of section-46 read with sub section (3) of the said section, section-2 of the Police Act, 1861 (Act no. 5 of 1861) and all other powers enabling him in this behalf, the Governor is pleased to make the following rules with a view to amending the Uttar Pradesh Sub-Inspector and Inspector (Civil Police) Service Rules, 2008 :

THE UTTAR PRADESH SUB-INSPECTOR AND INSPECTOR (CIVIL POLICE) SERVICE (SIXTH AMENDMENT) RULES, 2013

Short title and commencement	1. (1) These rules may be called the Uttar Pradesh Sub-Inspector and Inspector (Civil Police) Service (Sixth Amendment) Rules, 2013. (2) They shall come into force with effect from the date of their publication in the Gazette.	
Amendment of rule 5	2. In the Uttar Pradesh Sub-Inspector and Inspector (Civil Police) Service Rules,2008 herein after referred to as the said rules, in rule 5 for the existing sub-rule (2) set out in Column 1 below the sub-rule as set out in Column 2 shall be substituted, namely :-

	<p>(2) Inspector (a) 50 percent of the sanctioned posts of Inspector under sub rule (2) of rule 4 shall be filled by recruitment through promotion on the basis of seniority subject to rejection of unfit through the Board and the rest 50 percent of the sanctioned posts of Inspector under sub-rule (2) of rule 4 shall be filled by recruitment through promotion on the basis of departmental examination through the Board; (b) recruitment through promotions as mentioned in sub clause (a) shall be made from amongst substantively appointed Sub-Inspectors (Civil Police) who have completed 7 years of service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment, including the probation period; (c) Inspectors (Civil Police) promoted on ex-cadre posts who fulfil the requirement mentioned in clause (b) shall also be eligible for promotion to the post of Inspector.</p>	<p>(2) Inspector (a) Hundred percent of the total number of sanctioned posts of Inspector Civil Police under sub-rule (2) of rule 4 shall be filled by recruitment through promotion by the Board on the basis of seniority subject to rejection of unfit, from amongst substantively appointed Sub-Inspectors Civil Police who have completed seven years of service as such on the first day of the year of recruitment, including the probation period. (b) Inspectors Civil Police promoted on ex-cadre posts meeting the requirement will also be eligible for promotion to the posts of Inspector Civil Police under sub-clause (a)</p>
